



## Milwaukee County Zoo Admission Fees

Please note that the Zoo has a maximum daily student group capacity in warmer months, so all dates may not be available at the time of your call to register a field trip.

### Field Trip Reservation Information

Phone: Zoological Society Education Department at 414-258-5058, ext. 0 Monday – Friday 8:15am – 3:45pm. **Please inform the staff person who answers that you are booking a Kohl's-supported field trip.**

Policies:

- At least one adult is required for every ten students.
- Please book your visit at least four weeks in advance.
- Payment is to be made to the Zoological Society prior to the field trip date. You may not pay at the gate upon arrival to the Zoo.
- In order for your students to receive full attention, no unregistered children may attend programs – this includes siblings.
- Please notify the Zoo at time of registration if you have students with certified special needs.

### Admission Prices

#### November 1 – March 31

o **Milwaukee County Schools** – Monday-Friday: Free admission for students. One free adult admission per ten students; **additional** chaperone admissions are \$8.00 (Wednesdays) or \$9.50 (all other days).

*Kohl's Cares Field Trip applicants from public and private schools within Milwaukee County should budget only for the additional chaperone admissions for trips to be taken in this period.*

o **Non-Milwaukee County Schools** – All days: \$7.25 for preschool-8<sup>th</sup> grade; \$10.25 for grades 9 and above (including adults). One free chaperone admission per ten students.

#### September 1 – October 31 and April 1 – June 16

o **Milwaukee County Schools** – Wednesdays only: \$6.75 for preschool-8<sup>th</sup> grade; \$9.25 for grades 9 and above (including adults). *Note: Chaperones pay admission.*

All other days: \$7.75 for preschool-8<sup>th</sup> grade; \$10.75 for grades 9 and above (including adults). One free chaperone admission per ten students.





o **Non-Milwaukee County Schools** – All days: \$8.50 for preschool-8<sup>th</sup> grade; \$11.50 for grades 9 and above (including adults). One free chaperone admission per ten students.

Children with *certified* special needs (physical or cognitive disabilities) and their chaperones receive complimentary admission and parking. Registration is required.

**Parking** is an additional \$12 per car/ van or \$16 per bus (if bus stays on Zoo grounds – please determine if this will be the case before applying for a grant and registering your visit).
