- \$9 per student
 - Self-guided

- Education programs \$4 per student
- Required chaperones are free (grades 1-12: one adult for every ten children, K5: one adult for every five children); additional chaperones and adults must pay \$11.

Policies

- For grades 1-12, at least one adult is required for every ten students. For K5, at least one adult is required for every five students.
- Please book your visit at least four weeks in advance. Education, docent, and planetarium program availability and offerings are not guaranteed and subject to change.
- Confirm your head count with the Customer Service Representative two weeks before your visit.
 - Please Note: No changes in head count or program/ tour will be accepted after the two week deadline. The Museum cannot offer a refund if your head count decreases after your payment has been made, and cannot accept payment at the door.
- Prepare your students for your trip by going over the Behavior Contract.
- Prepare your chaperones; make sure they know the Chaperone Guidelines.
- We encourage each student and adult in your group to wear a name tag or school shirt that you supply. (This cost can be covered by the Kohl's Cares Field Trip Grant Program in the "Required Materials" section.)
- If you would like to have your students write or draw, please bring your own clipboards, pencils and paper. To protect the Museum's collection, only pencils are allowed in the galleries. (This cost can be covered by the Kohl's Cares Field Trip Grant Program in the "Required Materials" section.)

Wisconsin Stargazing
